POSITION: Home Visitor – Early Head Start (12 positions)

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

The Early Head Start Program is a home visitation program serving ages 0 – 3 year old children and families. The Home Visitor accepts referrals from intake team; conducts home visit, provides parent education with child development focus, and assists parents meet their educational and vocational goals. Collaborates with other providers for children 0-3 to facilitate a “seamless” service system, plans and implements participation in center based services and utilization of community resources appropriate to the needs of the families and children served by EHS.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Bachelor’s degree in early childhood education, special education, social work, or other related field. Certification preferred.
- A minimum of two years work experience with young children and their families preferred; familiarity with early intervention services to infants and toddlers locally or in Ohio; familiarity with agencies serving at-risk populations; and a demonstrated ability to work cooperatively with local agencies.
- Training in the field of early childhood disabilities and related development/learning disorders and developmental evaluations of young children (infancy – age 6).
- Experience in establishing partnerships with families, preferred.
- Willingness/ability to work as a team member and independently.
- Excellent organizational skills.
- Computer expertise appropriate to the position.
- History of good job attendance.
- Valid Ohio driver’s license with good driving record; daily access to private insured vehicle during work hours.
- Must pass criminal background checks, drug and alcohol tests and be free from communicable disease.
