## Services Offered:

There are children and adolescents in school communities experiencing serious emotional, behavioral and /or academic challenges. These students need therapeutic and behavioral interventions to assist academic achievement.

Union Day School provides the following mental health and behavioral services to assist and promote children's educational goals.

Academics through individualized curriculum and an online learning solution that assesses student's strengths and weaknesses.

Individual therapy where each student is assigned to a therapist who will meet with them at least twice per week.

Group therapy is provided on a daily basis. Sessions address cognitive lagging skills.

Family services provide an essential component in your child's placement at Union Day School. Services include families meeting with the child's therapist at least once a month and his/her case manager in the home setting on a weekly basis. Parent involvement is crucial for the child's success in school.
