## Why Wraparound?

Some families are looking for help for their child, but they struggle with finding and using the different supports available to them. The Butler County Family and Children First Council offers **Wraparound** to families of children with complex needs. Wraparound is a **planning process** that follows a series of steps so that children and their families realize their hopes and dreams. With the help of a Wraparound **facilitator**, people who care about the family's long term success form a team. Understanding the family's unique strengths, they problem-solve and plan in order to meet the needs of the family and the child.

## Upon Completion of the training, participants will be able to:

- Explain the Wraparound process
- Make an appropriate referral to Community Wraparound
- Learn to effectively participate on a family team
- Understand Butler County's vision for its System of Care
- Recognize the core principles of Wraparound
- Recognize the importance of community and system collaboration
- Assist with the creation and implementation of a Wraparound plan
- Learn about other opportunities for parents and professionals to get involved in Community Wraparound

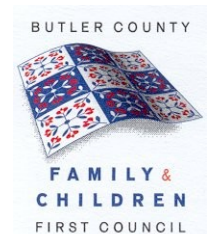
