Participants will complete the Online PLC course “Explicit Instruction” prior to the first session. In the first of two face-to-face meetings, we will explore the ideas and techniques presented in the training and apply them to our own situations. After implementing various strategies, participants return for the second meeting with specific experiences, and products to share, and plan for further application of the ideas.
