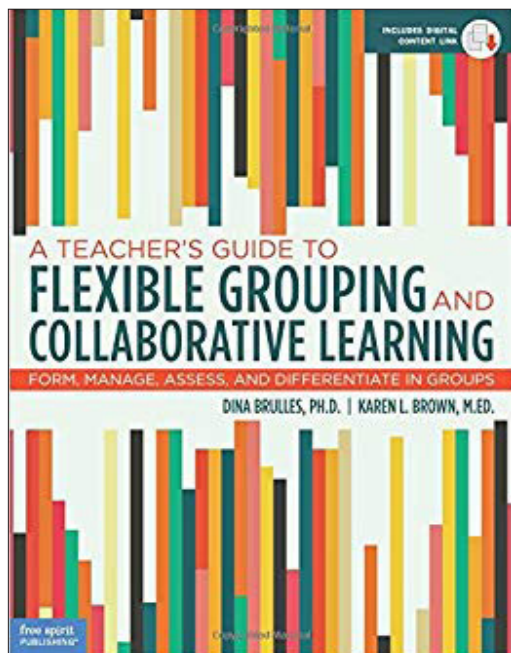


A Teacher's Guide to Flexible Grouping and Collaborative Learning
