Using a multimedia approach, BCESC will explore the needs of these underrepresented subgroups, as well as techniques that teachers can use to work effectively with students.

Participants will watch popular films featuring gifted students from these underrepresented groups such as “October Sky” and “Stand and Deliver” and/or “Finding Forester” to see these techniques in action. Additionally, participants will read articles about working with these subgroups, discussing the effect of different techniques and creating goals and action steps on how they can implement their learning into their classrooms.
