Nonviolent Crisis Prevention CPI Training and Refresher Training

Legislation regarding Seclusion and Restraint took effect on Sept. 1, 2012. This legislation requires that all schools have at least one staff member trained in appropriate seclusion and restraint techniques.

Nonviolent CPI Training (Full Course)

Dates: **Thursday, Sept. 6, 2018**
Wednesday, Jan. 9, 2019
Tuesday, March 5, 2019

Time: **8:00 AM – 3:00 PM**

Description: CPI Training is designed for people who are involved with students in potentially aggressive situations. This may include teachers, paraprofessionals, administrators, school psychologists, school social workers, guidance counselors, bus drivers and supervisors of lunchrooms and playgrounds.

CPI Refresher Training

Dates: **Friday, Sept. 7, 2018**
Thursday, Jan. 10, 2019
Wednesday, March 6, 2019

Time: **8:00 - 11:00 AM or 12:00 - 3:00 PM**

Description: This half-day session is for people who are seeking to *renew* their CPI certification. Nonviolent CPI Training is a prerequisite and *must* have been taken within two years to be eligible for the refresher training. Participants can choose morning or afternoon session.
